



Two-year institutions, also called community colleges, play an important role in the U.S. education system.

Time spent at these colleges provides a foundation for students to graduate from a better university. Classes are small, offering more attention to each student and encouraging participation and discussion.

Legal agreements between our host campuses and top universities nearby ensure that any student with at least 60 credits can transfer with third-year status to these participating four-year universities. These Guaranteed Admissions Agreements are enshrined in U.S. state law. Thousands of American students benefit from these agreements each year.

You Will Have Choices

UBridge Virginia students are guaranteed admission to 35 different universities, including the University of Virginia, a top 25 institution. You will be admitted on the basis of your GPA in the UBridge program. To progress to the University of Virginia, a popular first choice, the minimum GPA requirement is 3.4 – a goal attained by 100 percent of our 2015 class. But even if your program GPA is as low as 2.0, you will still have options for guaranteed admission.





Clear Requirements - And Help Meeting Them

We'll give you clear, concrete information on the criteria you'll need to meet to progress to your dream school. We'll also ensure you have the support you need to succeed.

UBridge staff are graduates of elite universities like Duke, Stanford, Michigan, the University of Virginia, and Columbia; they'll create a transfer plan customized to your major and target university.
