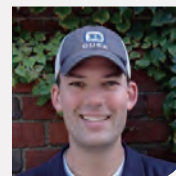

What is the Transfer Admissions Guarantee?

The Transfer Admissions Guarantee ('TAG') is a state-level agreement that allows students to transfer as a junior from a community college to participating universities, provided certain criteria are met.

Thousands of US students take part in the TAG program each year, as it provides the most assured way of transferring to an elite university.

- Enshrined in law
- No uncertainty - once the criteria is met, you can transfer
- No limit on the amount of students who can transfer
- Available to international students
- No need to ever take the SAT, or retake the TOEFL
- UBridge students graduate with the same degree as a four-year student
- Active for more than 40 years - thousands of students have benefited from the agreements

UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) for Students Applying for 2018-2019 Admission

Six University of California (UC) campuses offer guaranteed admission to students from all California community colleges (CCC). Interested students must meet campus-specific requirements to qualify for a UC TAG. By participating in a TAG program, students can ensure their admission to a specific UC campus. Also, some campuses may offer an early review of a student's academic record and specific guidance on major preparation and general education coursework.

Who can file a TAG?

Only students transferring directly from a California community college (CCC) are considered for a TAG, including international students (those with a visa).

A CCC transfer student is one who has completed at least 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units at one or more California community colleges, and the last college the student attended in a regular session (fall/spring or fall/winter/spring) before admission to a UC campus is a California community college.

Not Eligible for a TAG: Students who have already earned a bachelor's, graduate and/or professional degree; students who have previously enrolled at a UC campus during a regular term (not including summer session) cannot submit a TAG application to return to that campus; and students concurrently enrolled in high school.

To pursue a TAG, students must:

- Complete the online UC TAG application and submit it during the appropriate filing period – September 1-30, 2017 for fall 2018 (or May 1-31, 2018 for spring 2019) admission at ucop.universityofcalifornia.edu
- Once a TAG is submitted, fulfill all remaining coursework and GPA requirements designated on the TAG agreement.
- Apply for admission to UC during November 1-30, 2017 for fall (or July 1-31, 2018 for spring 2019) at universityofcalifornia.edu/apply.

Students are strongly encouraged to consult with their community college counselor prior to completing/submitting the TAG application.

Please note: transfer students do not have to participate in TAG to be considered for admission. Non-TAG students simply apply for UC admission during the appropriate application filing period.

GUARANTEED ADMISSION AGREEMENT University of Virginia College of Arts and Sciences and Virginia Community College System

The Rector and Visitors of the University of Virginia ("University") is pleased to guarantee the admission of Virginia Community College System ("VCCS") students according to the terms of this Guaranteed Admission Agreement ("Agreement"). VCCS students who do not meet the terms described herein may still apply and will be considered for admission, although admission is not guaranteed. Effective as of the date of signature by both parties, this agreement supersedes and replaces in its entirety the prior agreement between the parties executed March 15, 2008.

Section I: General Requirements for Undergraduate Admission to the College of Arts and Sciences

The University agrees to guarantee fall admission to the College of Arts and Sciences for a VCCS student who fulfills all of the steps described below.

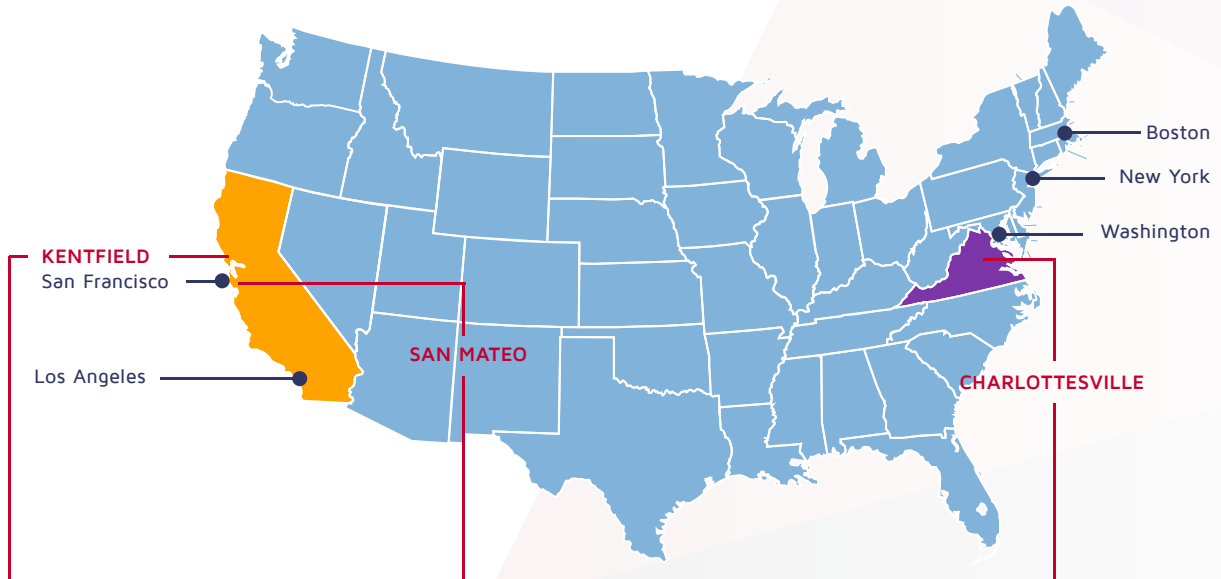
- Applies and matriculates to the University within the two-year period following completion of an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of Arts and Science degree in the VCCS. A student also may complete a General Studies associate degree that is approved as a transfer degree under the State Policy on College Transfer.¹ Coursework required under this Agreement must be completed by the end of the spring term in which application is made to the University.
- Completes a minimum of 24 credits of postsecondary coursework – not taken via dual enrollment – after completion of a secondary-level curriculum and is one year removed from completion of a secondary-level curriculum. Students who do not meet these criteria may apply to the University for regular first-year admission and will be considered on an equal basis with other applicants for admission as first-year students. Students earning an associate's degree prior to or concurrent with completion of a secondary-level curriculum are not eligible for admission under this Agreement.
- Earns a minimum of at least 54 transferable credits,² 45 or more of which are from the VCCS. This minimum may include dual enrollment credit, but not AP or IB credit. The University will evaluate AP and IB credit for an admitted student and award credit based on policies in place at the time the student enrolls.³
- Satisfies all competency and area requirements of the College of Arts and Sciences as specified in Section II.
