The Transfer Admissions Guarantee ('TAG') is a state-level agreement that allows students to transfer as a junior from a community college to participating universities, provided certain criteria are met.

Thousands of US students take part in the TAG program each year, as it provides the most assured way of transferring to an elite university.

- No limit on the number of students who can transfer
- Available to international students
- No need to ever take the SAT, or retake the TOEFL
- UBridge students graduate with the same degree as a four-year student

UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) for Students Applying for 2023-2024 Admission

Interested studen sust meet campus-specific requirements to qualify for a TAG. By participating in a TAG program, students can ensure their admission to a specific Campus. 
CCC transfer student is one who has completed at least 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units at one or more California community olleges. The last college the student attended in a regular session (fall/spring or fall/winter/spring) before admission to a UC campus must be a alifornia community college.

tot Eligible for a TAG: Students who have already earned a bachelor's, graduate and/or professional degree; students previously enrolled at a UC ampus during a regular term (not including summer session only) who plan to return to that same campus; and students concurrently enrolled ir igh school at the time of TAG application submission.


o pursue a TAG, students must:

- Complete the online TAG application and submit it during the appropriate filing period September 1-30, 2022 for fall 2023 admission (o May 1-31, 2023 for winter/spring 2024) at uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu.
- Once a TAG is submitted, fulfill all remaining coursework and GPA requirements designated on the TAG agreement
- Apply for admission to UC between October 1 and November 30, 2022, for fall 2023 (or July 1-31, 2023, for winter/spring 2024) at <u>apply university of california edu</u>. TAG students <u>must</u> submit a UC application; submitting the TAG application alone is not enough. The TAG major and major on the admission application must match.
- Note: TAG/admission decisions will be based on all academic information available at the time of review. Dropping required courses and/a earning non-passing grades in coursework may result in a change in your TAG/admission eligibility. Grade changes or adding courses to meet TAG criteria after the decision is made will not be considered.



Many professors teach at both institutions, and PVCC students have access to excellent facilities at UVA, including the UVA libraries. Second year PVCC students can also take classes at UVA. Over 20% of all PVCC transfer students are admitted to University of Virginia.
